Ginger was a natural tracker, easily gaining her Tracking Champion title which combined with her Show title made her the first Australian Cattle Dog in Australia to achieve a Dual Champion status with Tracking. This also meant that she was only the second ever ACD in Australia to gain a Dual Championship.

Ginger was a wonderful mother and produced some outstanding pups for our kennels, passing on her happy nature, her excellent movement, and her keen ability for the sport of Tracking.
